The gruesome incident happened on December 16, 2012, and the victim subsequently died on December 29, 2012. The vigil was held outside the Indian High Commission office in London.

The Diocesan Council has decided to arrange Mission Trips in 2013 to the various mission fields in India. Since 2013 is the Jubilee year of the Diocese, the India Mission Trip will be for five different groups, and will give more opportunities for the younger generation in this Diocese to know about the Indian mission fields, and the ongoing mission programs at various centers. The Diocese is considering sending different teams from USA, Canada and UK to Mumbai, Delhi, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka - Andhra Pradesh, and Tamilnadu - Kerala. Each group's visit will be for a span of 10 to 15 days during the months of June through August, 2013.
