MESSAGE FROM THE BISHOP

Dearly beloved in Christ,

The Mar Thoma Church is having a series of spiritual conventions in its various dioceses prior to the annual convention at Maramon, Kerala, in February 2013. The theme for this year's convention is: *You shall be my witnesses*.

More than 100,000 people will be attending the annual convention at Maramon. This meeting is drawing global attention and therefore the Church has invited guest speakers from the East, West, North, and South. It is customary that all the bishops, clergy and lay members find it a place to meet God and people, listen to the Word of God, and commit themselves to carrying out the mission and ministry of the Church with more vigor and enthusiasm.

In a legal context, a witness is a person called to openly narrate what that person knows about an incident for which a judicial procedure is going on. He/she can say what he/she has seen, heard or understood about the incident. Jesus after his resurrection and before his ascension told the disciples that they shall be witnesses of Jesus to the whole world. Such a witnessing is possible only with the help of the Holy Spirit. As St. John says in his first letter that they cannot but speak of Jesus whom they have seen, heard, touched and understood. This they carried out through their lives.

The Church today is called to bear witness to the Lord. The Mar Thoma Church is a witnessing Church. That is why we have the Ashram movement where a group of people can go and stay with the larger community, either to shed 'light into their lives' or 'become salt of the earth' for integration and empowerment of the people for a fruitful living. That is why we have so many institutions to take care of the victims, the wounded, the crushed or those who are less privileged, marginalized or cast out. That is why we have so many mission fields to preach to them the good news of Jesus Christ and to work towards the total sustained development of the community.

Whom do you witness today? The Silver Jubilee of our Diocese is reviving our members through the various programs to be true witnesses of the living Lord by journeying with Him all along.
