

DIOCESAN ASSEMBLY MEETING

The Diocesan Assembly of the Diocese of North America and Europe of the Mar Thoma Church was held at the Mar Thoma Church of Greater Washington on Wednesday, July 4, 2012 and Thursday July 5, 2012. The Diocesan Episcopa presided over the meeting. The Assembly meeting was blessed with the presence and leadership of Rt. Rev. Dr. Thomas Mar Theethos Thirumeni. Rev. Dr. M. C. Thomas led a study session on the theme, 'Covenant and Reformation'. Ninety-eight assembly members attended the meeting. The assembly honored Dr. T. M. Thomas for his contributions in the overall growth of the Diocese, particularly in Diocesan Sunday School. The Assembly passed the Diocesan Annual report and Accounts for the year 2011 and Annual budget for 2012. Decisions were taken for the administration of the Diocese and for its spiritual and financial growth.

DIOCESAN CLERGY MEETING



The Annual Diocesan Clergy - Family Conference was held at the Mar Thoma Church of Greater Washington from July 3-4, 2012. Rt. Rev. Dr. Geevarghese Mar Theodosius, Diocesan Episcopa, Rt. Rev. Dr. Thomas Mar Theethos and Rev. Dr. M. C. Thomas were the leaders. "The Covenant of the Minister and His Family" was studied. Fifty-one Achens and their family attended the meeting. The meeting felicitated the Diocesan Bishop for the blessed completion of 40 years of ordained ministry, Mar Theethos on his Episcopal consecration and all Achens who were celebrating their ordination jubilee. There were also separate sessions for Kochammas and Children.

2012 MAR THOMA CHURCH FAMILY CONFERENCE

The 30th session of the National Family Conference of the Diocese of North America and Europe was held at the National Conference Center, Virginia from July 5-8, 2012. Rt. Rev. Dr. Thomas Mar Theethos, Diocesan Bishop of Mumbai Diocese inaugurated this year's conference and led bible studies. Rt. Rev. Dr. Geevarghese Mar Theodosius gave presidential address and exposed the theme; 'Remembering the Covenant for a Reforming Church". Rev. Dr. M. C. Thomas, Director of TMAM Orientation and Research Center led the main talks. Worship services were led by Achens and delegates from various regions. Rev. Roy Geevarghese, Philadelphia and Rev. Thomas John, Los Angeles led devotional talks. There were separate sessions for Adults, Youths and children. Dr. Christopher Varghese led a session on Medical concerns. About 700 people from 270 families attended the conference in 2012. This was jointly organized for the first time by the Diocesan Council and the parishes of the South East Region.



OKLAHOMA NATIVE AMERICAN MISSION-10 YEARS OF MINISTRY



The Camp with the Native Americans in Broken Bow, Oklahoma conducted from June 4 to 8, 2012 marked the 10 anniversary of the joint ministry between the Native Americans and the Mar Thoma Church.
