

Message from the Diocesan Episcopa

Dear friends in Christ,

The Jubilee celebrations of our Diocese are progressing. On July 6, 2013, we held the sixth regional jubilee celebration at the St. John's Mar Thoma Church, New York. All the parishes in the Diocese observed Jubilee Sunday on July 7th, and I believe that many people participated in the recent chain of prayer. The various jubilee programs energized our community to remember the past with gratitude, celebrate the present with praises and thanks giving, and look to the future with confidence and hope. Christ the Lord is with the church to journey from the known to the unknown, from safety and security to spheres of insecurity, and from the temporal to the eternal. As we look towards the next phase of the growth of our Diocese, there is a greater need to understand the rapid changes happening around us. We have the faith and assurance that with Christ in our vessel we can smile at the storm.

Among the unique initiatives during the jubilee year is the introduction of Altar Boys and Covenant Girls. The intent of these programs is to identify boys and girls above the age of 12 and who are communicant members to commit themselves to serve the Church by going through a training program for 3 years (before they begin studying at colleges and universities). Therefore, we are establishing a training for Altar boys and Covenant Girls at the regional and/or center levels. The training program covers topics such as (1) Introduction to the Bible and preparation of Sermon (2) Prayer habits and discipline for daily Meditation (3) Introduction to the Liturgy of Holy Qurbana, including Thooyaba (4) Sacraments and Faith practices (5) Church History, Mission and Ministry (6) Teenage challenges and leadership role.

The boys will assist the Achens at the Altar, the Covenant Girls will help in the Sanctuary. Once they complete the initial training and the dedication service, they will be given a badge for the parishioners to identify them. A dress code preferably white is ideal. Once they successfully complete the three years of training under the leadership of the parish priest, the Diocese will issue a certificate to each participant.

Let us journey with Christ for a brighter future.

A Vacation Bible Class (VBS) was held at Colonia Mar Thoma (Mexico Mission) from June 27 to 29, 2013. About 50 students from the local community attended the VBS. Twelve youth members from Immanuel MTC, and Trinity MTC, Houston, participated. Ms. Arlene Mathew, provided leadership for the VBS sessions. Several local teachers, including Betzy Murillo Silva (a medical student supported by our diocese) actively participated in the VBS. Rev. Saju Mathew, and Rev. Dr. Philip Varghese were also present and provided leadership. Philip Varghese Achen officiated the Holy Communion Service on Sunday. About 120 people attended the service and about 15 people participated in the Holy Qurbana. The Lessons were read in Spanish by Colonia residents. Also the message was translated to Spanish.
