

Message from the Diocesan Episcopa

Dearly beloved in Christ,

The Silver Jubilee programs of the diocese included a dialogue between the senior citizens and young families. A paper was presented in New York on September 28, 2013 during this dialogue and it raised two questions: How is the church supporting the senior citizens to age gracefully? What activities are being planned by the diocese for the senior citizens?

The Mar Thoma Church observed September 15, 2013, as the Senior Citizen Sunday. Our Metropolitan through his Circular No. 170 stated that there are two sections of people who are above the age of 60. One section consists of those who are healthy enough to be engaged in various activities, and the other section who are aged and either completely bed ridden or dependent to varying degrees. The church intends to have a Senior Citizen's Fellowship in all our parishes. The parishioners should visit the aged people who are confined to their homes or nursing homes for offering them friendship and fellowship. Let us remember that the practical wisdom of the aged is a wealth to the community. Those who are healthy enough among the senior citizens should take initiatives to give spiritual and social fellowship to those who need assistance for living. The various organizations of the parish can strengthen this ministry and also help the Vicar to organize communion services regularly in the parish on a weekday or at times when pastoral attention is requested.

Our parishes can organize half a day program either in the morning or in the afternoon and can include recreation and health activities along with spiritual nourishment. Our regions of the Diocese where there are number of parishes, can attempt adult day care centers, assisted living centers and nursing homes.

Let us live the Word of God which says; "honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you" (Exodus 20: 12)
