Dearly Beloved in Christ,

The 33rd Diocesan Youth Conference was hosted by the Youth Fellowship of the Trinity Mar Thoma Church, Houston, at the South Shore Harbor Resort and Conference Center, from August 9 to 12, 2012. PRESS RELEASE FROM THE DIOCESAN EPISCOPA

The Diocesan Episcopa issued a press release denouncing the recent activities of terrorism in US and Canada. In it he offered heartfelt condolences to the bereaved families and friends of the victims of these tragedies, appreciated the commitment and leadership of the law enforcement officials involved in these incidents, offered prayers for the repentance, remorse and restoration of the shooters themselves.

He stated, that "... All religious institutions should become a source for promoting greater harmony and peace amongst all peoples. Life is a gift of God. It is to be protected and promoted. It is the responsibility of every human being to protect life and to enhance the life of all living beings. Life negating activities of any kind is a crime.

Religion and religious organizations should not become a target for terrorism. People of all faiths should have the freedom to practice their beliefs without any fear of persecution. Freedom to practice one's faith and religion is one of the fundamental principles upon which our nations are founded. The Mar Thoma Diocese of North America and Europe joins me in paying that God will grant everyone the wisdom and grace to live a life of peace and communal harmony in the very land that we have made our home. May the peace of God prevail amongst us."
