

MESSAGE FROM THE BISHOP

A team of "New Generation" Marthomites from North America will be arriving, under the leadership of O. C. Abraham and Nirmala Abraham, at the Aldersgate United Methodist Church on June 14, 2012 to stay there for a week. The *Mowa-Choctaw* Native American community, at Mount Vernon, Alabama, will welcome them, provide accommodation in their houses, cook food and celebrate fellowship together. More than the celebration and fellowship, it is a festival of the Word of God where children gather every day for a week for Vacation Bible School and the adults assemble to hear the Word of God. This mission activity started in 2003 and this year is the 10th Anniversary of this spiritual festival.

This activity is a part of the Church's outreach mission, as well as an example of ecumenical living. Mission is from God and Jesus Christ is the greatest missionary. He incarnated, preached, taught, healed and gave His life for the redemption of the entire created order. The resurrected Lord appeared to the disciples on the evening of Easter and said, as the Father has sent me, I am sending you. He breathed on them the Holy Spirit. The church continues the Mission of God. The mission to the *Choctaw* community is a humble effort of the Mar Thoma Diocese of North America and Europe. You and I have a role to play here. Mission is to find out a need and respond to it in God's love.

The Mar Thoma Church is an ecumenical church as well. More than the ecumenical relationship that we know of between church denominations, every member of the Church has a role to play in working with others within other geographical areas and amongst their neighbors.
